



Track Notes:

A. 800' station track; 1870-1911

Structure Notes:

1. Station built in 1870; new station in 1892; removed in 1934.
2. The Grove Hotel, originally the Gilchrist residence built in the 1840's and later remodeled into a hotel. It burned in 1964.
3. RR Bridge replaced in 1891 and again in 1943.
4. Originally covered bridge built in 1816, partially replaced in 1843 then completely replaced in 1903 with a steel one.
5. Section Tool House; c.1890-1911 at this location then moved north of Glen Creek bridge until removal in 1926.
6. Shed in c.1870 photo; probably original section house.

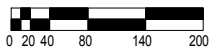
